The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by club president, Sam Birchfield. The April minutes were read and accepted. Treasurer's report was read: balance brought forward was \$39,863.72 deposits were \$20,950.00, disbursements were \$12,095.29 with an ending balance of \$48,718.43.

### Old Business:

- Wobble Trap was repaired for under \$700.00 and is ready to be picked up. The club will pay any club members fuel to go pick up the wobble trap from Georgetown SC. Contact Sam.
- The gates that were donated to replace the chain at the 100 yard line are up. Also, the road beside the club house is now closed to vehicle traffic. When the 200 yard range is in use the procedure is the same as always, the new gates should be closed as well as the gate to the left of the club house to signify 200 yard range in use and opened when range is not in use.
- Kyle and his crew have finished all of the masonry work and painting of the club house. A big thank you to Kyle.
- Tim Drum reported that two used plate racks and several new pieces of center fire rated hanging steel have been purchased for the outdoor pistol range. Also, more swinging steel targets has be purchased to be placed at all distances on the rifle range. Hanging steel at the 25 and 50 yard berms are pistol only.
- When using the new plate racks be sure the orange reset bar is fully hidden before firing at that plates. This will prevent damage to the reset bar.
- The 4H club has trimmed the tree limbs on all the roads and removed limbs from all the ranges as a service project. Thankyou 4H!
- Both tractors were serviced and old tractor's fuel leak is now fixed.
- A tax attorney has been contacted and appointment made for review of clubs non profit paper work.
- The outdoor pistol range berms and parking area are being addressed by Brian and will be completed soon.

### New Business:

- Work party will be held June 15 at 5pm, ranges will be closed starting at 4pm.
- Keith Harper requested use of the pistol range for classes 9/8, 10/13, 9/29-30, 11/17-18. Club approved request.
- The gutters on the 100 yard building need to be cleaned out.
- 4H asked the club for help with cost for the coming year. A motion was made to give 4H \$1000, motion was seconded and passed.
- A motion was made to spend \$100 on a memorial for Ira Cline. Motion was seconded and passed.
- Keith brought before the club the need for A/C in the meeting room. After discussion Canella heating and air will be consulted to determine the need and cost.
- Several loads of gravel will be spread on the 100 yard range parking area.
- Kyle Watts will give the club an estimate for replacing the door for the indoor range.



- The Policy Manual committee will be meeting June 11<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 pm to work on club polices for match directors. All match directors are asked to come and help out with this section.
- Tom Johansen is working on putting up a Knock Box. This will allow for emergency services to have access to a gate key in the event on a medical emergency on the range while the gate is locked.
- Club members are advised to be sure toilets are not running continuously after flushing.
- The .22 TSC match will be held June 9
- The .22 speed steel match will be held June 23 at 9am on the pistol range.
- Tim Frady was voted into membership, welcome Tim.
- Meeting adjourned at 8:30pm
